RULES & REGULATIONS

GENERAL GUIDELINES (For All Students)

1. Eligibility to Vote:
 - Only bona fide students of the college with valid College ID Cards are eligible to vote.
 - Each student is allowed to vote only once.
2. Dress Code on Election Day:
 - All students must be in formal/college dress code.
 - NCC cadets must report in proper uniform.
3. ID Proof Mandatory:
 - Students must carry their College ID to enter the polling zone.
4. Discipline and Decorum:
 - Strict discipline is to be maintained throughout the election process.
 - Use of abusive language, shouting of slogans, or any form of instigation is strictly prohibited.
5. Election Timing:
 - Voting will take place from 9:00 AM to 12:30 PM.
 - Counting of votes will begin at 1:00 PM.

FOR CANDIDATES (Campaigners/Contestants)

1. Code of Conduct:
 - Campaigning must remain issue-based, positive, and non-political.
 - No caste, religion, or language-based propaganda is allowed.
2. Prohibited Activities:
 - Use of banners, posters, or flyers on college walls is strictly prohibited.
 - Offering gifts, treats, or any form of monetary inducement is not allowed and will result in strict action.
3. Permitted Campaigning:
 - Campaigning is allowed only till 2:00 PM on 31st July 2025.
 - Use of microphones, loudspeakers, or mass gatherings is prohibited after this deadline.
 - All campaign materials must be fully removed from campus by the cut-off time. Violations will invite disciplinary action.

FOR NCC CADETS AND ELECTION DUTY OFFICIALS

1. Polling Booth Setup:

- To be completed by 8:30 AM under the supervision of the ANO.

2. Cadet Responsibilities:

- Cadets will be assigned duties for:
 - Entry management
 - ID verification
 - Queue control
 - Ballot box security

3. Counting Room Protocol:

- Only authorized personnel will be allowed inside during counting.
- Confidentiality must be strictly maintained until the official declaration of results.

VIOLATION & PENALTY

- Any violation of the rules by a candidate will result in immediate disqualification.
- Misbehaviour by any student will attract disciplinary action as per college norms and the Discipline Committee.
- Campaigning after the specified deadline will result in direct disqualification.

BY-ELECTION PROVISION

- If any elected member of the Student Council is found to be inactive, non-participative, or disengaged from assigned responsibilities, and a formal request is received from any committee or department, the Election Commission, with the approval of the Principal, reserves the right to organize and conduct By-elections for the concerned post(s).
