Pending approval of the Syndicate, Dr. K.S Ravindranath, Former Vice-Chancellor, Rajiv Gandhi University and Health Sciences, Bengaluru, is appointed as Ombudsman for Bangalore University, Bengaluru, as per University Grants Commission (Redressal of Grievances of Students) Regulations, 2023 with immediate effect for the period of three years or until he attains the age of 70 years, whichever is earlier.

A separate order will be issued for sitting fee, perdiem and Travel expenses.

Functions of Ombudsman:

- The Ombudsman shall hear appeals from an aggrieved student, only after the students has availed all other remedies provided under the regulations.
- 2. While issue of malpractices in the conduct of examination or in the process of evaluation may be referred to the Ombudsman, no appeal or application for revaluation or re-totalling of answer sheets from an examination, shall be entertained by the Ombudsman unless specific irregularity materially affecting the outcome or specific instance of discrimination is indicated.
- The Ombudsman may avail assistance of any person, as amicus curiae, for hearing complaint of alleged discrimination.
- 4. The Ombudsman shall make all the efforts to resolve the grievances within a period of 30 days of receiving the appeal from aggrieved students(S).
