The webinar on Stock Market exemplified the fundamental concepts pertaining to the financial markets, which has become imperative to trade in the stock exchange. The Shine Projects put forward some of the courses offered by their institution to the students. The resource person of the webinar was Mr. Venkata Sri Harsha, Founder of Shine Projects, India’s leading online education platform located in Hyderabad. The session was conducted under the guidance of Dr. Ramya R, Principal of Surana College. ## Chemistry


● The Department formed 'Alchemy Club' to initiate innovative activities among the students. Students of II year B.Sc, prepared an organic soap under the guidance of Ms. Meenaakshi Srinivasan, Assistant Prof. of Chemistry, on 24th December 2021. Students grouped themselves into three to prepare organic soap using three different organic materials such as Neem leaves, Aloe vera extract and Tulsi leaves which were collected by students in the surroundings of the college. Students learnt the procedures to prepare organic soaps and they were inclined to use organic products which were chemicals free and good for skin health. They were also motivated to prepare organic derivatives like face wash and hand sanitizers.

## History

● The Department of History organised a Historical trip exclusively for BA students on 25th of February, 2022 to Sharavanabelagola, Belur, and Halebidu to explore the art & architecture of temples constructed by the Hoysala rulers during 11th Century to 14th Century. 14 student participants were accompanied by Ms. Prarthana Singh, Asst. Prof. of History. Where on the day of the trip (i.e., 25th Feb 2022) the team left the Surana college Peenya campus at 6:00 AM in the morning and reached the first destination point i.e., Sharavanabelagola at 09:20 am, where the team visited the Gomateshwara Statue by climbing more than 900 steps and visited Vadegal Basadi. At these places, the team learned about the 24 Tirthankaras and the inscription written by Boppana on Gomateshwara. The team left Sharavanabelagola at 10:30 am for Belur and reached Belur at 12:40 pm. The participants visited the Chennakeshwara Swamy temple and explored the beautiful art and architecture of the Hoysala empire with the help of an approved guide. The team learned about the history and origin of the Hoysala empire, and were made aware of the interior architecture of the temple. This was followed by a visit to the Yagachi dam, which was located 3 km far from the Chennakeshwara Swamy temple to see the majestic architectural dam and explored water sports. The team left Belur at 04:00 pm for Halebidu. The team reached the third destination Halebidu at 5 pm and visited the Kedareshwara temple and observed that the idols of the temple were looted by Malik Kafur, a general of Alauddin Khilji. Followed by that, the team came to the Hoysaleshwara temple, which was known for external beautiful art and architecture built by the ministers of the Hoysala empire. With the help of the guide, the team came to know about the history and architecture of the Hoysala empire. The team left Halebidu at 6:30 pm. While coming back to Bangalore the team had dinner at Sri Chamundeshwari food villa and successfully reached the college campus at 11:10 pm. The aim of the trip was achieved as the students learnt to appreciate Indian Art and Culture.

## Rotaract Club

● The Club organised an event on 'Organ Donation Awareness' with Rotary Bangalore Udyog by Mohan Foundation on 17th December, 2021. The Event was presided by Smt. 

### **Counselling Cell**



● The Committee in association with Research Committee organized a session on ‘Competency Mapping’ on 21st of March,2022. Dr.Vanishree M.R, Dean–Research & Consultancy, SEI initiated the session on ‘Competency Mapping’ in association with Surana Wellbeing Centre, a counselling wing of Department of Psychology, Surana College, Kengeri to the faculties at Peenya campus to understand the strength and capabilities of the faculties in the area of research. The counsellors from Surana Wellbeing Centre namely, Ms. Bhanupriya, Ms.Sridevi and Mr. Saptharshree had come to the campus and interacted with 33 faculties with respect to their interest towards research. The objective of conducting session was to help the faculty become more efficient, effective and competitive. The Councillors provided questionnaire to the faculties to fill it up during the interaction. The session paved the platform for few of the faculties to come up with their personal issues to discuss with the counsellors which were hindering their progress. The counsellors counselled them and also advised them to come to the Surana Wellbeing Centre for further counselling.

### **Research Committee**

● Research Committee in association with Research and Consultancy Centre, SEI conducted “Three Days - Research Training Programme” from 25-04-2022 to 27-04-2022 between 10:00 AM to 4:00 PM. Teaching Faculty members attended the programme. The objective of the programme was to facilitate complementary skills among the faculties with respect to research fundamentals and also to provide hands-on training pertaining to SPSS software. Dr.Vanishree M.R, Dean – Research & Consultancy, SEI had given the Pre-assessment test before starting the session to analyze the research knowledge among the faculties. Then, she introduced the Research Paper Template which comprises of the following procedures: Title, Abstract, Key words, Introduction, Review of Literature, Methodology & Materials, Result Analysis, Discussion, Future Research & References. The erudite speaker explained each one of the procedure in detail and also emphasized on the importance of value driven outcome of the research. Later, the training programme was continued by the guest speaker Mr. Saptarshree Mazumdar, Assistant Professor, Surana College, Kengeri wherein the speaker explained the meaning of variables, types of variables, Hypothesis – Null Hypothesis & Alternate Hypothesis, Errors in testing hypothesis, Different types of tests like t- test, Z test, ANOVA (one way & two way) and MANOVA (one way & two way). By concluding the Day-1 session, Dr. Vanishree ma’am had assigned the task to the faculties for selecting the theme of their respective domain and present the title, objective, methodology and discussion points by analyzing five research papers of their interest. On Day-2 session, Dr. Vanishree ma’am elucidated how to go about the Review of Literature, cropping of the data, intervention study followed by identifying the research gap and thereby freezing the title for the study. She also taught to frame the research objectives and preparation of questionnaire depending upon the respondents. The eloquent speaker articulated the differences between citation, references and bibliography. She helped us to understand how to match the objectives with the findings and also highlighted the importance of discussion or the conclusion for the



research paper. She notified to mention about the future research topic in the current research paper. By winding up the Day-2 session, Dr. Vanishree ma'am had given an assignment pertaining to the identifying the research gap and there by freezing the research title and also framing the research questions related to the chosen title. On Day-3 session, Mr. Saptarshee Mazumdar took over the session by introducing the concepts pertaining to the meaning of sample, sample size, methods of sampling, types of population, margin of error, variability, calculation of sample for an infinite population and also the calculation of sample size for a finite population through some formulae. The resource person explained the different tools in checking the reliability and validity of the data. He also described the meaning of item pooling, item writing, pilot testing and scales of measurement. Subsequently, the orator helped us to understand the calculation of regression, correlation, chi-square test through SPSS software. He also made us know that the few of the statistical tools can also give the result through MS Excel. By wrapping up the three days' sessions, Dr. Vanishree ma'am had given us the post-assessment test to analyze the outcome of the research training programme.

Born in Oxford, England in 1942, Stephen Hawking was one of these few. This great man took physics to the people and changed the way we thought about disability .

The chances in 1963, that thus 21 years old would survive a motor neuron disease much more than two years were next to zero. Yet through an extra-ordinarily consistent force of will that he would live, think and strive to accomplish as much as he could, he carved out a dream to reality. Because of his motor neuron disease Hawking had to undergo tracheotomy in 1985 that removed his ability to speak on his own. But he never stopped talking and communicated through speech synthesized by twitching his facial muscles. Hawking once responded -“Know your history, the discovery of intellectual life elsewhere in the universe would be the biggest scientific discovery ever “. He is most popular for his theory in the field of cosmology. His theory predicted that black holes would exclude radiations, whereas, in a purely classical picture nothing could escape the black hole, not even light. He resolved this contradiction by invoking quantum mechanism.

There is no doubt that with Hawking's death the world has lost an outstanding scientist. But he was not only a path breaker in the world of science but came to be known to millions with the publication of “A brief history of time” his best selling book describing in non- technical terms, the structure, development and fate of the universe. He ranks with Isaac Newton and Albert Einstein as a rare physicist who fired the popular imagination. His life carried to the public not only the secrets of cosmos but also the promise of hope and human endeavour. He showed that disability need not hold a person back in the pursuit of his dreams. He leaves behind a wealth of knowledge and also the conviction that the will to survive can overcome all odds.

We are here to love, not harm

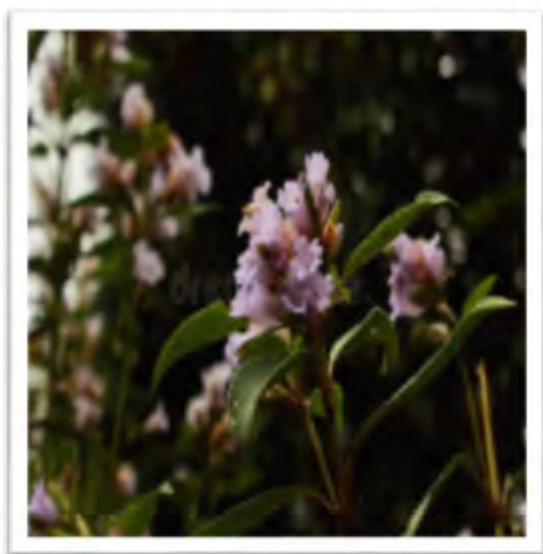

## NEELAKURINJI



'Strobilanthes Kunthiana' known as Kurinji or Neelakurinji, is a shrub that is found in the Shola forests of Western Ghats in Karnataka, Kerala and Tamil Nadu. The word 'Neelakurinji' means 'Blue flower' in Malayalam language. Niligiri mountains got its name from the neelakurinji flowers. The name neelakurinji is believed to be inspired from the river Kunthi. This flower is also known as the 'flower of love' by locals. This flower grows at an altitude of 1,300m to 2,400m.

The shrub is usually 30cm to 60cm high. Plant which blooms after long period are known as Pletesials, they are known to exhibit gregarious flowering habit. Neelakurinji belongs to Pletesials. This flower takes 12 years as the pollination for the neelakurinji flowers need such longer period. In botany, this is referred to as 'survival mechanism' of plants. Longer pollination helps the species to escape total destruction by predators or even due to climatic changes.

While neelakurinji poses the greatest threat from the birds and grass-eating mammals, there is a chance that annual pollination might increase the biological threat to the species and thus it takes such an extended period to bloom. During the neelakurinji blooming season, costs of honey reaches the maximum as nectar collected during this season is believed to be supreme in taste and nutrition aspects. The rare blooming of this flower also attracts tourists, nature lovers across the state and native districts who are making a beeline to witness the beauty of nature.

The flower has 250 varieties and they bloom at different times, while some bloom in a gap of 5 years others take around 12 to 14 years. A total of 46 varieties of neelakurinji flowers are found in India. The plant has also got medicinal value – Leprosy, to control blood sugar, Vata disorders, Skin inflammations or allergy, Urinal problems, Jaundice and excess menses.

The last bloom of neelakurinji in India was in July 2018 in Munnar hill located in the Idukki district of Kerala. The last bloom of neelakurinji in Karnataka was in 2021 in Mandalpatti hills in the district of Kodagu, while the entire region is blessed with this natural beauty.

**हजार बर्क़ गिरे लाख आंधियां उठें वो फूल खिल के रहेंगे जो खिलने वाले हैंल**

साहिर लुधियानवी के ये लफ़्ज़ बयां करते हैं 'आयरन लेडी ऑफ़ पाकिस्तान', मुनिबा मजारी की ज़िन्दगी को। पाकिस्तान सुनकर भौंएं चढ़ाने वाले भी इस महिला की कहानी को पढ़कर अपने अंदर एक सकारात्मकता महसूस करेंगे।

पाकिस्तान के बलोचिस्तान की हैं मुनिबा। जैसा कि ज़्यादातर बलोच लड़कियों के साथ होता था मुनिबा की भी शादी उनके माता-पिता ने सिर्फ़ १८ साल की उम्र में कर दी। माता-पिता की अच्छी बेटी बनकर मुनिबा ने भी दूसरों के द्वारा लिखी गई अपनी क्रिस्मत को स्वीकार कर लिया। बलोचिस्तान की महिलाओं के साथ ऐसा ही होता था तो मुनिबा के पास कोई और चारा भी नहीं था।

शादी के २ साल बाद, २००७ में मुनिबा एक भयंकर दुर्घटना का शिकार हुईं। उनके पति खुर्रम शहज़ाद गाड़ी चलाते-चलाते सो गए थे और गाड़ी खाई में जा गिरी। खुर्रम ने खुद को कार से बाहर निकाला और मुनिबा कार में ही रहीं। मुनिबा को कार से खींचकर निकालना पड़ा। २१ साल की उम्र में किसी और की ग़लती की वजह से मुनिबा ज़िन्दगी भर के लिए पैरालाइज़्ड हो गईं। उनकी रीढ़ की हड्डी टूट चुकी थी, उनकी बांह, कंधे, कालरबोन और रिब केज टूट गए थे। उनके लिवर और फेफड़े भी क्षतिग्रस्त हुए थोडक़्टर्स आते और मुनिबा को उनके स्वास्थ्य के बारे में बद से बदतर खबरें देते।

डक़्टर्स ने उन्हें पहला शक़ दिया कि कंधे और बांह में लगी चोटों की वजह से अब वो कभी पेंटिंग नहीं कर पाएंगी। दूसरा शक़ ये दिया कि स्पाइन में लगी चोट की वजह से वो कभी चल नहीं पाएंगी। तीसरा और सबसे दर्दनाक शक़ ये दिया कि स्पाइनल कर्ड में लगी चोट की वजह से वो कभी जन्म नहीं दे पाएंगी।

मुनिबा ने अपनी मां से पूछा कि ऊपरवाले ने उनके साथ ही ऐसा क्यों किया? मुनिबा की मां के पास भी कोई जवाब नहीं था। मुनिबा कई बार खुद से पूछती, कि आखिर वो ज़िन्दा ही क्यों हैं? ऐसे हालातों में भी मुनिबा ने सकारात्मक रहने की पूरी कोशिश की। जो भी उनसे मिलने आता वो उनके सामने हाथ-तौबा नहीं करती और मुस्कुराकर मिलतीं। इस रवैया पर कई लोग पूछ देते कि वो सच में 'ठीक' है न?

मुनिबा ने निर्णय कर लिया कि 'वो खुद के लिए जीएंगी। मुनिबा ने तय कर लिया था कि वो किसी के लिए 'परफ़ेक्ट' नहीं बनेंगी। वो समय लेंगी और खुद को खुद के लिए बेहतर बनाएंगी। मुनिबा ने अपने सभी डर का सामना करने का दृढ़ निश्चय कर लिया और सबको एक कागज़ पर लिखा और एक-एक करके सबका सामना करके जीतने की ठानी।

मुनिबा ने व्हीलचेयर पर बैठे-बैठे ही वो कर दिखाया जो शायद उसके एक्स-पति या पिता कभी नहीं कर पाएं। मुनिबा ने कई ऐड कैम्पेन किए, पाकिस्तान के टीवी पर बतौर एंकर काम करना शुरू किया, पेंटिंग करती रहीं और दुनिया को दिखाया कि व्हीलचेयर पर बैठा इंसान क्या-क्या नहीं कर सकता। मुनिबा पाकिस्तान की पहली व्हीलचेयर बाउंड मडल हैं, पहली व्हीलचेयर बाउंड एंकर हैं।

मुनिबा मजारी को पाकिस्तान की पहली ऊज्ज्वल रश्मि अष्टल्लल्ल बनाया गया। २०१५ में ऑऑइ की १०० अधिकांश पेरणादायक महिलाओं की लिस्ट में मुनिबा को शामिल किया गया है।

मुनिबा की कहानी मिसाल है हम सबके लिए। हमारे पास सबकुछ होता है पर हम अपने पैरों की बेड़ियां तोड़ने में हिचकिचाते हैं। सब कुछ होते हुए भी हम विकलांग सा जीवन जी रहे हैंल बड़ा न सही पर छोटे-छोटे कामों से ही नाम बड़ा बनता हैल कोशिश तो करके देखिए, ये पूरा जहां आपके इंतज़ार में बैठा है।

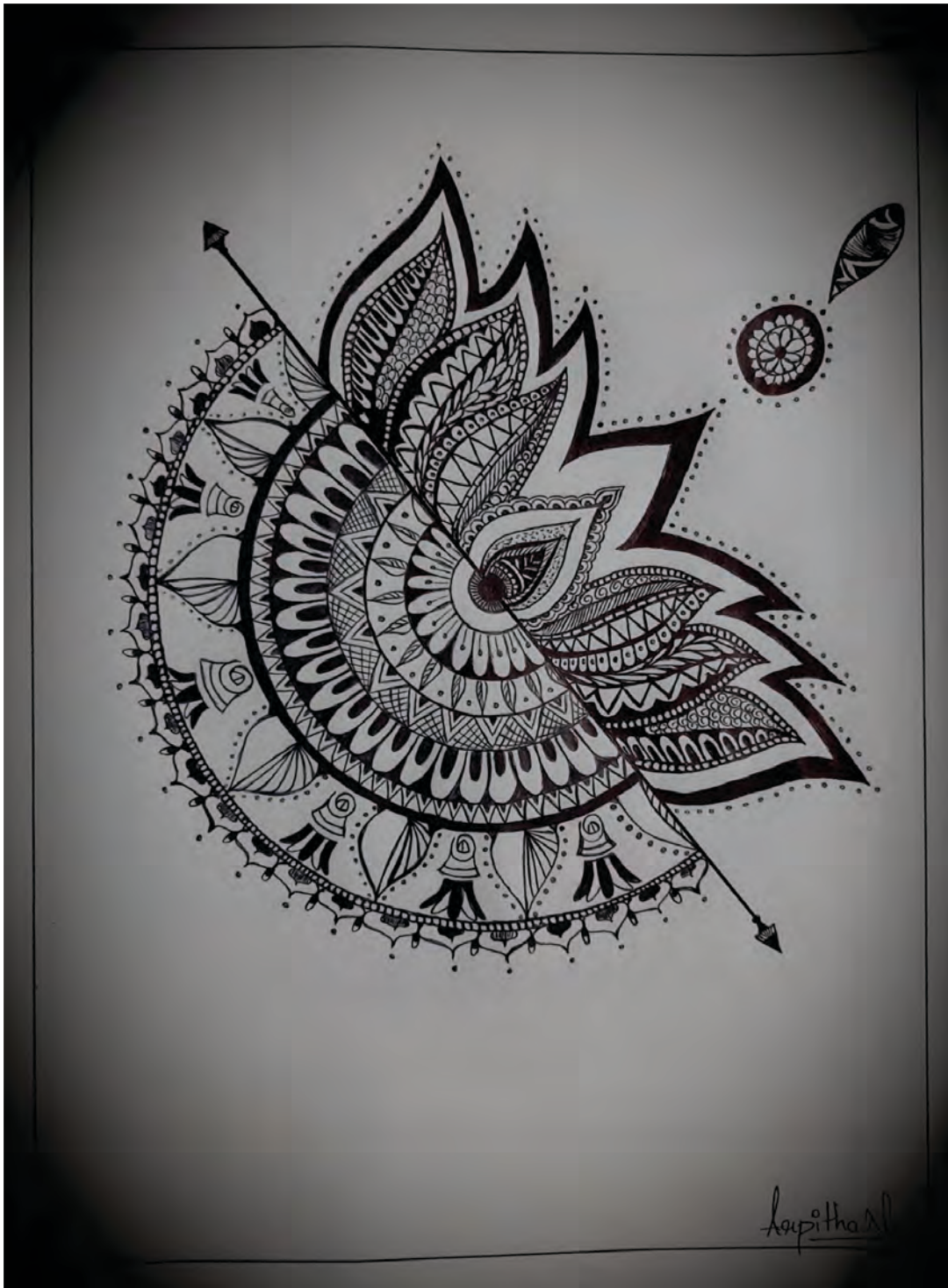
